Youth Entrepreneurial Services exists to promote young people's creative skills and employment potential through innovation, creativity and engagement in career development.

This innovative social enterprise assists young people to create, sell and market their products and services online and through pop-up stores and markets using uniquely designed retail modules.

- YES participants will be between 15 and 24 years of age and will gain high quality job-seeking skills through in-house programs such as 'Coaching Young People for Success' and 'Ready Set Job'.
- One of our key outcomes is that participants will have a clear employment pathway and will achieve employment, further education or certified training.
- YES meets approved jobactive activity requirements.
- YES gives participants real, immediate exposure to the world of work and the satisfaction of achievement.
- Participants will gain knowledge and practical experience in design, manufacture, marketing, e-commerce, stock control, administration, retail and management.
- YES addresses vocational and non-vocational barriers to getting a job.
- YES provides support from youth and employment coaches, skills specialists, community mentors and business hosts.
- YES can tailor the hours of participation to suit individual circumstances.

To be eligible participants must possess one or more of the following:

- Unemployed for 6 months or more
- Identify as Indigenous
- Early school leaver
- Enrolled in alternative education
- Live or have lived in out of home care
- Have a disability
- Homeless, or at risk of homelessness
- Have dependents
- Have unemployed parents
- Have criminal or legal issues
- Living in a regional or rural location
